Subject: Instructons regarding joining of duties in respect of those Medical  
Officers who are appointed on regular basis and pursuing their  
P.G. Course/Registrarship.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that consequent upon the appointment of doctors on regular basis vide this Department's Notification of even number dated 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2011, applications for extension in joining time in respect of those doctors who are pursuing their P.G. Course/Registrarship within State / out side the State are pouring in this Department. These representations/applications have been examined at Government level and after careful examination of such requests the following has been decided:-

- i) That keeping in view the shortage of Medical Officer in the State no extension in joining period of all such MOs will be granted in any case;
- ii) That all these newly appointed MOs will be eligible for Residency/Sr. Residency only after serving for two years being regular MO.
- iii) That all doctors already doing Sr. Residency must join by 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2011 and they will be given teaching experience certificate of Sr. Residency which they have done.
- iv) That after two years service they will be permitted to complete the remaining Sr. Residency without appearing in examination.

- v) That they will be eligible for PG Degree/Diploma etc. only after fulfilling the requirement afresh after regular posting.

You are, therefer requested to ensure that all newly appointed MOs join by 30th July, 2011 positively, failing which their offer of appointment shall stand cancelled. The Institution-wise details of joining by these MOs may be sent to this Department.


